• Use: 3rd-person writing only (as if you the writer were not the subject of the story); quotations (real or made up), and "newspaper style" based on what you know from reading articles

- 2. Why do you want to be a member of the Torch staff?
- 3. The Torch is a student publication. How do you respond to the leadership of other students? If you were asked to fill a leadership role on The Torch, what would be your own leadership style?

4. What is your vision of the role of a newspaper on a school campus?

5. From what you have seen, how has The Torch done in fulfilling its role and responsibilities? How should it change?

6. Come up with three good ideas for stories that have not appeared in The Torch but should. They can be ideas for any section of the newspaper.
